2) OBJECTIVE AND SCOPE OF WORK:

- 1. Assessment and calculation of eligible carbon credits from fuel switch to biomass fuel in place of coal in the milk processing plants of Bhopal Dugdh Sangh Sahkari Maryadit at Bhopal, Pachama and Betul.
- 2. Facilitation of the entire process of accrual of carbon credits including selection of appropriate agency / platform for registration, verification, validation and issuance of verified carbon credits and their sale.

Name of Project: End to end consultancy service for availing carbon credits from thermal energy generation projects through biomass in Bhopal, Pachama and betul.

The consultant would be responsible for selection and finalization of the registry platform such as VERRA Or gold standard or GCC and would perform the following tasks:

- Step 1: Preparation of Project Information Note (PIN) based on carbon footprint mapping, development of baseline for the project, preparation of Project Development Document (PDD) based on an appropriate approved monitoring methodology. The PDD would be submitted for approval and registration to the appropriate program (Gold standard foundation or VERRA or GCC etc)
- Step-2: Stakeholders consultation, primary evaluation of the project by the selected platform and approval of the PDD.
- Step-3: Validation- Validation of the project would be conducted by an accredited validator.
- Step -4: Registration of the project with Gold standard foundation or VERRA.
- Step -5: Verification, certification and issuance of verified carbon credits.
- Step -6: Facilitating sale of Verified carbon credits issued.

Dugdha Sangh Mydt. who does not bind himself to accept a tender in whole or in part or reject any or all the tenders received without assigning any reasons and no explanation can be demanded of the cause of rejection of the tender by any tenders.
- 5.5 The Chief Executive Officer, BSDSM reserves the right to place order for whole requirement with any tenderer or split the orders among one or more tenderers or not to purchase at all any item even after rate approval.
- 5.6 Each tender should be accompanied with copy of PAN, GST, Firm Registration, ITR of 2 Assessment Year (2021-22, 2022-23).
- 5.7 The tenderers should submit the rates online only. The conditional tender are liable to be rejected.
- 5.8 No person or firm is permitted to submit more than one tender under different names.
- 5.9 The tenderers shall not sublet the contract or assign to any other party or parties, the whole or any portion of the contract without prior written permission of Chief Executive Officer, BSDSM.

Bid Validity

Bid shall be valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening.

6) LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

6.1 liquidated damages may be charged as under:-

7) PAYMENT:

A success fee, for an amount equivalent to 2% (Two Percent) of the value realized from the sale of carbon credit, excluding all indirect local taxes but including Expenses towards the project registration with the chosen carbon offset standard, third party VVB fees for validation and verification, issuance fees, and any other such expenses will be paid after successful sale of Carbon Credit.

8) CONSEQUENCES OF BREACH OF AGREEMENT:

If any firm under the contract commits breach of any of the conditions, it shall be lawful for the Chief Executive Officer, Bhopal Sahakari Dugdha Sangh Mydt. to cancel the contract and to purchase material from any other alternate sources on the risk and cost of the defaulting unit.

- 9.3 All disputes between tenderers and BSDS matter will be put to MD, MPCDF for resolution. In case no resolution action will be taken as per <u>Arbitration Act. 1996.</u>
